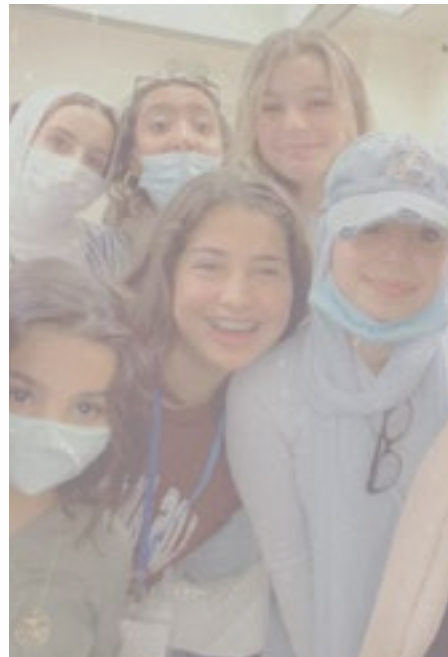

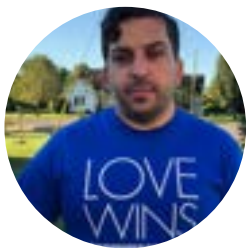
OUR MISSION

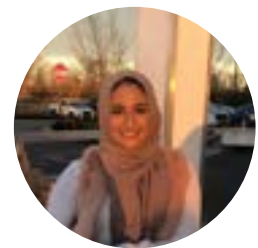

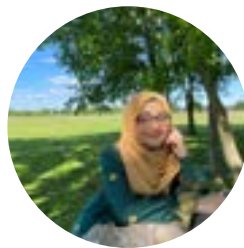

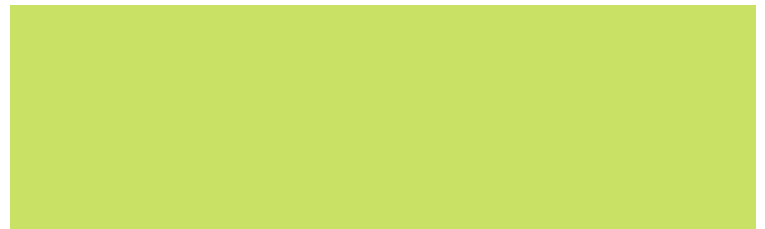
OUR FINANCES

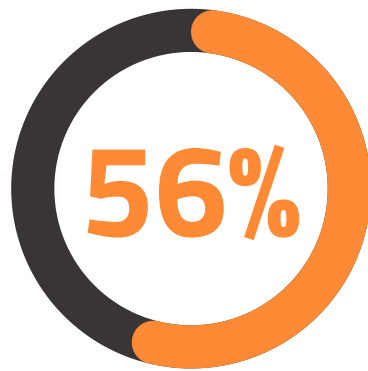

Sources of Income

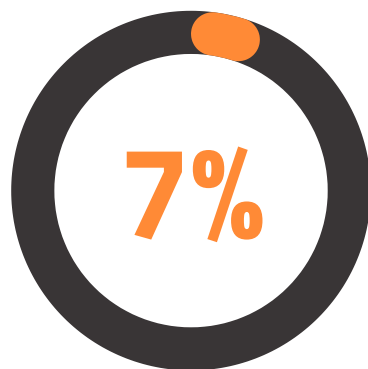
In 2021 we raised a total of \$215,420.
They came from many sources and over 257 unique donors.



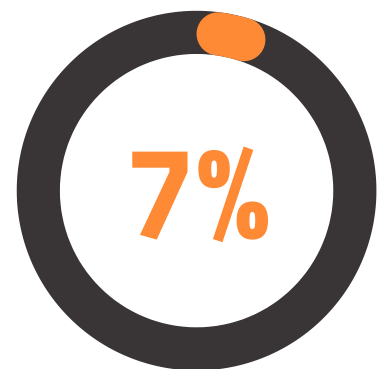

In August 2020, we moved into our first office space ever. Tens of our youth worked on renovating, painting, furnishing, and decorating. We are testing our ability to put the space to use and cover its overhead.

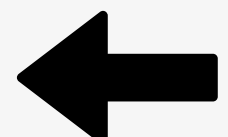
